In 1961 Concannon was the first winery in America to varietally label and bottle Petite Sirah (releasing it in 1964). Grown on Livermore Valley's rocky soils, this has always been a standard bearer for us in style and character. Concentration is key here, and six months in French and American oak offer finesse, smoothness, vanilla and mocha notes and creamy texture. Transition mid-palate from cherry to blueberry is sensational. Can you believe it's only \$12? (SRP)
