FINE WINES

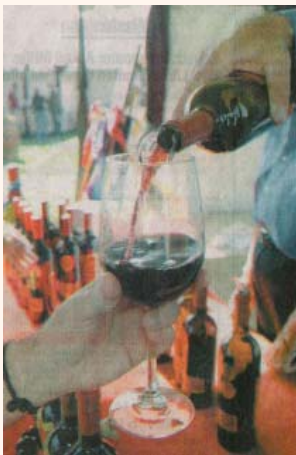
Organizers could not have asked for better weather Saturday as the Loose Goose Wine Festival kicked into high gear...
